### Rules:

1. See Exhibit Rules
2. Entries open to any exhibit grown in Ohio County.
3. All exhibits must be grown during 2017 season.
4. All hay must have been baled by mechanical baler.
5. Judges will consider:
  - \*Uniformity and size
  - \*Uniformity in color
  - \*Cleanliness and neatness
  - \*Freedom from blemishes
  - \*Kernel shape
  - \*Eye appeal of display
6. Open Youth Division (OY) - Ohio Co youth, age 18 or younger  
Open Adult Division (OA) - Ohio Co Adults, age 19 or older

**Premiums:** 1st - \$5 2nd - \$3 3rd - \$2 4th - \$1

**Premiums for tobacco entries:** 1st - \$7 2nd - \$5 3rd - \$3 4th - \$1
