## Canning

### Rules:

1. See Exhibit Rules.
2. All canned entries must have been canned since last year's fair.
3. All entries must be home canned. All jars with 2 piece lids shall have ring on.
4. Jelly must be in STANDARD jelly or pint glass jars.
5. Canned food must be in clear STANDARD (pint or quart) MASON jars and may be opened during judging. Food not in standard jars will not be accepted.
6. Jars must be vacuum sealed at time of entry and judging.
7. WE DO NOT SAMPLE CANNED GOODS \*\* UK does not recommend canning squash, pickled squash is acceptable\*\*
